Rose Class Visit to Rosuick Farm

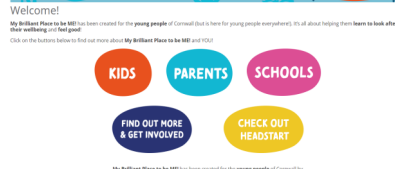

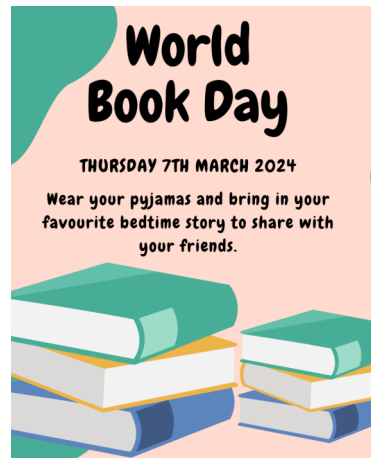
