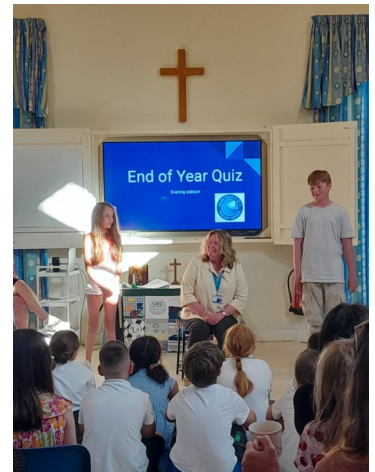
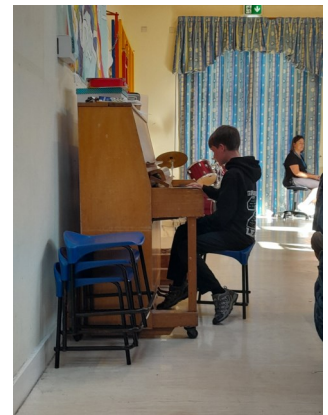
## Summer Spectacular Performances
