Road Safety Assembly

Today in our celebration assembly we had a special visit from PCSO Julia Berryman. She came to talk to the children about the importance of road safety. She taught the children the mantra, 'stop, look, listen,' and spoke about how to safely cross the road.

She also emphasised the importance of wearing helmets when riding bikes and scooters. The children were reminded that they need to be over 135cm to travel in a car without a booster seat and that they must always wear a seat belt. They have all come home with either a slap band or a clip for their coat / backpack from 'vision zero', a charity aiming to spread the word about road safety and to prevent accidents on our roads.
