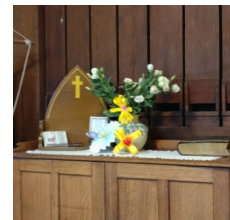
Our Vision Statement

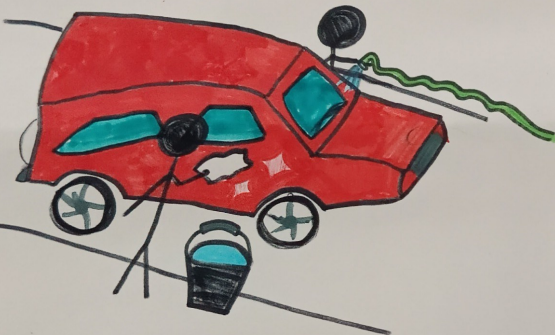

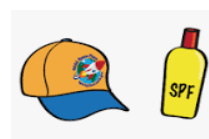
